### West Valley's Floren sprints to 100-meter dash win at Pasco Invite

PASCO — Breakout season's starting to feel like an understatement for West Valley sprinter Cody Floren.

The sophomore sprinted to a 100-meter win at Saturday's Pasco Invite with a personal-best of 10.85, good for sixth-best in Valley history and one hundredth of a second ahead of Tumwater's Blake Kirkpatrick. Floren's won four of five races in the 100 this season and he's already taken nearly half a second off his personal-best from last year, which earned him eighth place at the CBBN district championships.

Senior Gavin Case recorded an astounding personal-best of his own to win the discus with a school-record mark of 175 feet, the third-longest throw in Valley history and less than six feet off the record set by Grandview's Titus Jeffrey at last year's state championship meet. Case's winning throw beat his previous best by more than 10 feet and gave him the second-best mark in 2A this season.

Ellensburg's boys team finished fourth thanks in part to the efforts of James Hall, who won the high jump by matching his personal-best of 6-4. Reigning district champion Mystic Hammond gave the Bulldogs a fourth-place finish in the 3,200 while Carlos Patino took second and Silas Stewman netted fourth in the shot put.

Zillah's Aysia Garcia sprinted to a pair of top five finishes, highlighted by second place in the 100 with a time of 12.27 seconds. Davis senior Ella Craig shined in the hurdles by setting two personal-bests, capturing second with a time of 14.79 in the 100 and fourth in 45.71 seconds in the 300.

West Valley's Callie Orcutt continued her phenomenal freshman season by clocking the Valley's seventh-best 1,600 in a personal-best time of 4:58, good enough for second-place and eight seconds ahead of former West Valley Middle School teammate, Ike freshman Hadley Hanchett. Max Gallegos also ran to second in the boys 800 meters with a personal-best time of 1:55.38.

Selah's girls topped all Valley teams in tenth place with a lot of help from Chloe Myers, who captured second place in the discus with a throw of 143-5. She also took fourth in the shot put, fifth in the high jump and seventh in the javelin.
